

# College Credit Application Checklist for Project Lead The Way (PLTW) Engineering, Computer Science, and Biomedical Science Courses

## DEADLINE TO APPLY

**11:59 p.m. MONDAY, DECEMBER 31, 2018**

**FALL/SPRING TRANSCRIPT CREDIT** – students who apply between NOW - 11:59 p.m., Dec. 12, 2018, AND whose teacher has verified their PLTW End-of-Course Assessment score, will receive credit on the December 2018 Ulowa transcript. If between December 13 - December 31, 2018, the student will receive credit on the May 2019 Ulowa transcript. The University of Iowa College of Engineering will no longer offer college credit for PLTW courses after December 31, 2018.

### **Parents: A stanine score on the End-of-Course Assessment (EoC) of 6-9 is required to receive college credit**

- 1) Please go to [www.pltwiowa.org](http://www.pltwiowa.org) to apply for PLTW college credit.
- 2) Go to the **College Credit** tab and click on **PLTW College Credit Application**. Then click on the appropriate application (**Engineering, Biomedical Science, or Computer Science**). Fill the form out completely. This information is required by the Admissions Office at the University of Iowa. Please be assured, all information collected is secure.
- 3) At the end of the application process, you will be redirected to a secure website where you can pay the **non-refundable** application fee by credit card. **Please note: American Express is not accepted.**
- 4) You will receive a confirmation email that your application and credit card transaction have been completed.
- 5) Notify your PLTW teacher that you have applied for college credit through the University of Iowa. They must verify your score before 11:59 p.m. on December 31, 2018. Please see "Teachers" below.
- 6) **Credit and Fees:**  
Your student will receive 3 s.h. of college credit and a grade of Satisfactory (S) for PLTW Engineering Courses, PLTW Computer Science Courses, and the PLTW Biomedical Science Courses (at a **non-refundable** application fee of \$150.00 per course). Your student will receive 1 s.h. of college credit and a grade of S for Principles of Biomedical Science (at a **non-refundable** application fee of **\$75.00**).
- 7) **Grades:** Students will be given a letter grade of S (Satisfactory) on the University of Iowa transcript. This grade corresponds to a grade of C or higher. By providing a satisfactory grade in lieu of a letter grade, your student's college grade point average will not be affected by a class taken in high school. However, the college credit will count toward the total credits needed to graduate.
- 8) Once the admissions process is complete, you will receive an electronic packet from the University of Iowa with a congratulatory letter, Certificate of Completion, and instructions on how to order transcripts (transcript information is also found on the [pltwiowa.org](http://pltwiowa.org) website under "College Credit"). These packets are sent out at the end of the University session (January, June, and September).

### **Teachers: A stanine score on the End-of-Course Assessment (EoC) of 6-9 is required to receive college credit-DEADLINE to submit student EoC Scores is 11:59 p.m., December 31, 2018**
